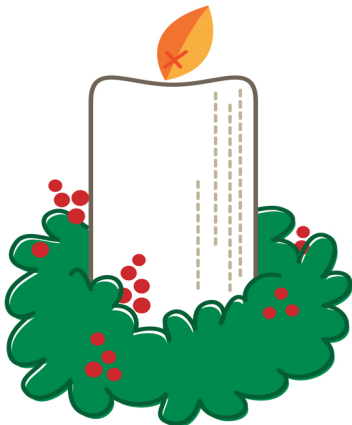
The Tree

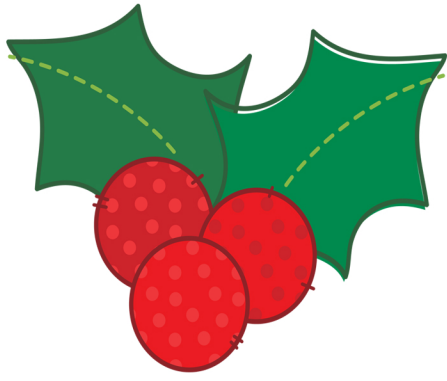
The Candy Cane

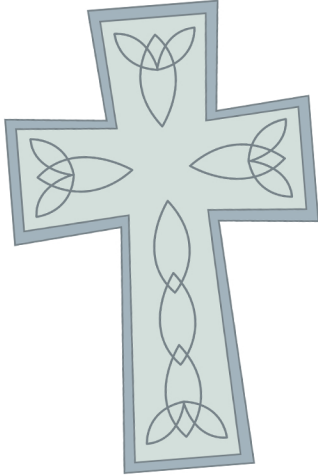
The Star

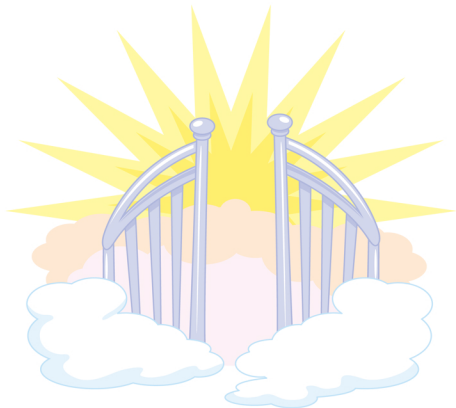
The Cross

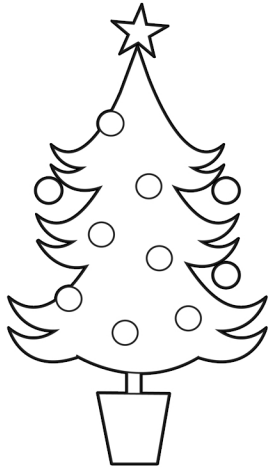

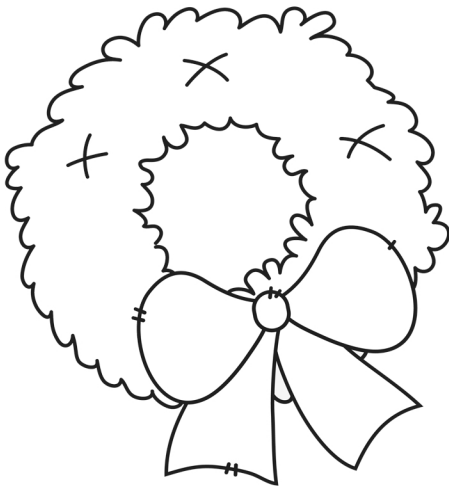

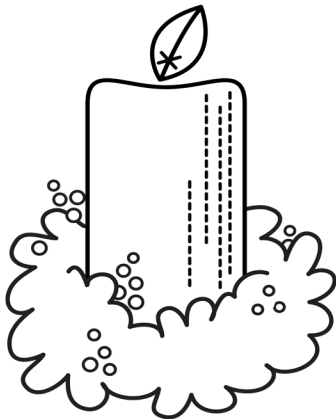
The Tree

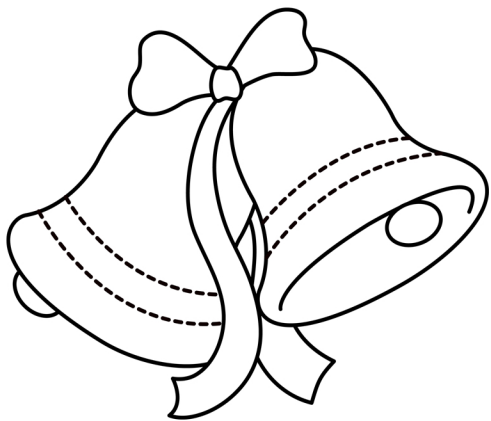
The Wreath

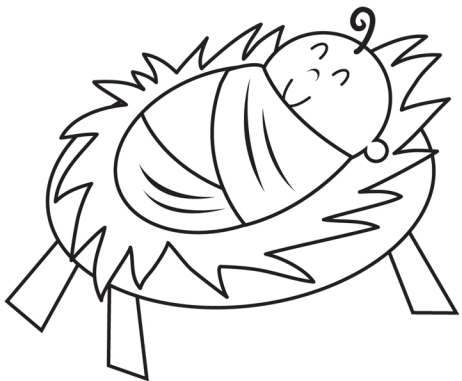
The Candle

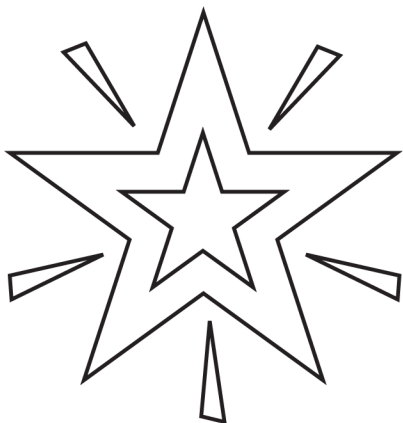
